- Remove the four (4) bolts on each fender rail.
- Install each sissy bar bracket with the bend to the inside (part number) using the supplied 8mm x 65mm bolts. Install the thicker (.170) spacer on the front bolt between the bracket and the fender rail. Install the thinner (.095) spacer on the rear bolt between the bracket and the fender rail.
- Attach the sissy bar to the brackets using the supplied 8mm x 16mm bolts.
