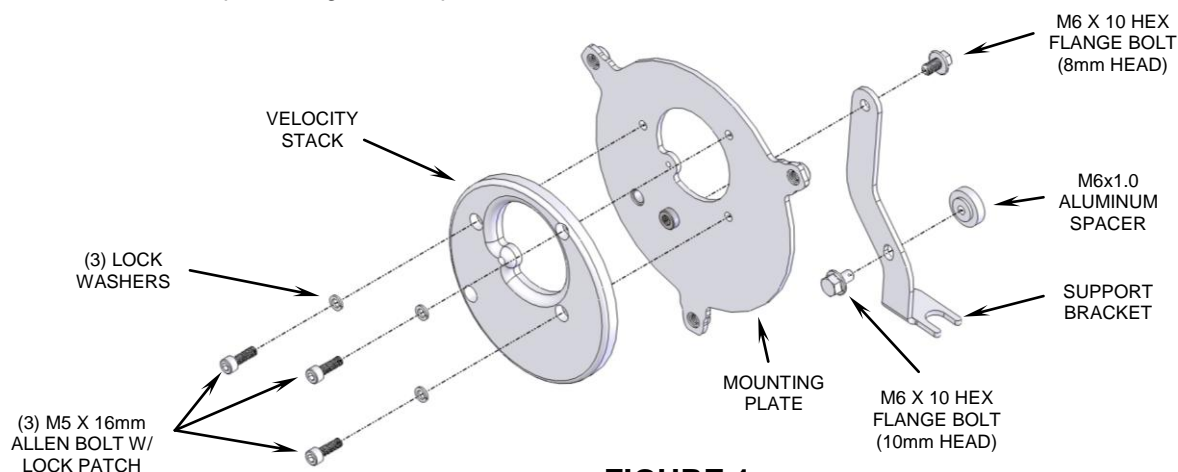
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Read all instructions carefully and completely before installing your new POWRFLO™ Intake.

1. Remove the seat. Remove the hex bolt at the rear of the fuel tank. Prop the rear of the fuel tank up 2 - 3 inches with a block of wood to allow access to intake. Do **NOT** remove gas lines and be careful not to scratch or drop tank, assistance may be needed.
2. Remove the (5) bolts that secure the stock air cleaner chromed cover. Remove the cover and the stock air filter. Remove the hex bolt from the lower portion of the air cleaner housing. (NOTE: The rubber coated nut that secures the hex bolt may need to be held in place with pliers, to prevent from rotating.)
3. Loosen the (3) phillips-head screws around the carburetor to remove the air cleaner housing from the carburetor.
(NOTE: Carefully rotate the air cleaner housing outwards from the bottom to disengage the intake snorkel that resides under the fuel tank. Assistance may be needed to further lift the gas tank for clearance.)
4. On the backside of the air cleaner detach the two rubber hoses by squeezing the hose clamps with a pair of pliers and sliding them past the hose inlets. Disconnect the idle adjuster and leave hanging for now.
5. Use the (1) supplied M6 x 10mm hex flange bolt (with 8mm head) to attach the support bracket to the backside of the mounting plate. Snug the bolt into the threaded insert but do not tighten. See Figure 1.
6. Insert the supplied breather filter into the larger hose that was disconnected in Step 4 and secure with the stock hose clamp. See Figure 2 for position.

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7. Reroute and attach the smaller hose and hose clamp that was disconnected in Step 4, to the inlet tube on the backside of mounting plate.
8. Using the (3) supplied M5 X 16mm allen bolts and lock washers, attach the velocity stack and mounting plate (with support bracket) to the carburetor in the order shown in Figure 1. Fully tighten the allen bolts.
9. Align the installed support bracket with the bracket between the cylinder heads. Insert the (1) supplied M6 x 10mm hex flange bolt (with 10mm head) through the support bracket, cylinder bracket and thread into the supplied M6 aluminum spacer. See Figure 1 and Figure 2. Make sure the small diameter boss on the aluminum spacer is fully engaged into the hole on the backside of the cylinder bracket, then tighten.
10. Now fully tighten the M6 x 10mm hex flange bolt (with 8mm head) securing the support bracket to the mounting plate. (NOTE: tightening bolt may be difficult due to tight working area).
11. Attach the idle adjuster to the support bracket retaining tab. See Figure 2.
12. Place the supplied K&N® filter onto the velocity stack. Insert the round intake screen into the black ring so the screen sits inside the edge of the ring. Place the ring and screen between the legs of the naked black intake cover as shown in Figure 3.
13. Place the naked intake cover, ring and screen assembled in Step 12, over the air filter and align each leg to the base mounting plate threaded holes. Be sure screen sits at a 45 ° angle to the bottom leg, and C/V logo'd leg is at the upper left position. Insert the (3) supplied 1/4"-20 x 1/2" buttonhead bolts through the intake cover and into the base mounting plate, see Figure 3. Double check all parts are aligned properly and tighten securely.
14. Lower the fuel tank back into place and secure with original bolt and washer install seat and secure properly.
15. Check that all bolts and clamps are properly secured and sealed before starting motorcycle.

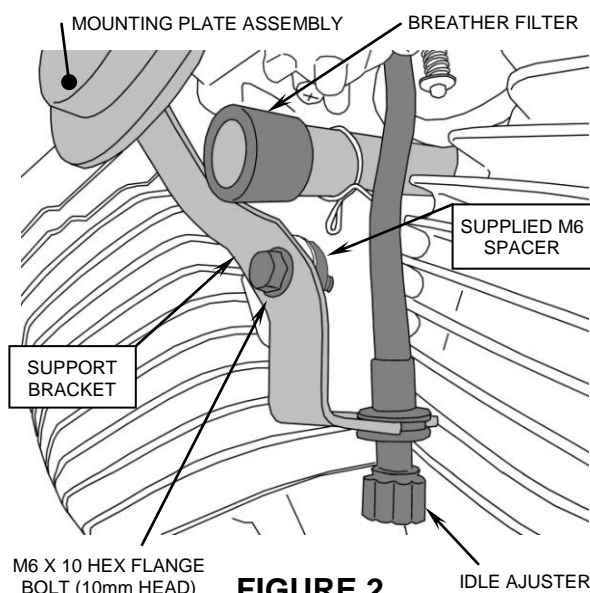

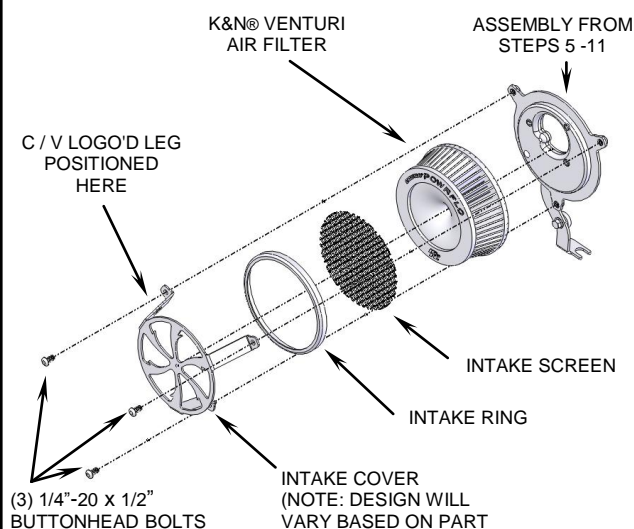

Abrasives may breach the coating and shorten life.
